A town without a running water supply

Benefiting from the Daisetsuzan Mountains, Higashikawa is the only town in Hokkaido that uses groundwater. Residents' lives are closely related to water. In addition to drinking pure mineral water, tasting rice and vegetables grown with the water is also part of daily luxury. Why not take a trip to get closer to the town through water-related attractions?

- Chubetsu Dam -

This dam completed in 2007 is located on the Chubetu River, which is part of the Ishikari River system. Its functions include flood control, conservation of the river environment, power generation, and supply of irrigation water and drinking water. There are parking lots nearby with views of the dam, where you can see the beautiful nature of the four seasons.

- Daisetsu Gensui Park -

The mineral-rich snowmelt water from Asahidake gushes out here in an endless stream. The water temperature remains at 6 to 7°C all year round. From the parking lot you can walk along the wooden path to the source.
